





BC ADULT GRADUATION DIPLOMA (Adult Dogwood)



The British Columbia Adult Graduation Diploma (BCAGD), also known as the "Adult Dogwood" is one of two graduation diplomas offered in B.C. schools. The Adult Dogwood is for students 18 years of age and older and requires 20 credits of study. This credential differs from the Dogwood Diploma, which requires at least 80 credits. Students in the Adult Graduation Program are not required to complete the Graduation Numeracy or Literacy Assessments.
