The Community Wellness Network Governance Working Group has now concluded its work with the creation of network guidelines, a budget, and a process for inviting members to the network's Coordinating Circle.

The coordinating circle will provide leadership to the Nanaimo Community Wellness Network. They will also look after finances, and guide the activities of the network to achieve its goals.

Overall, the network is the collaborative effort of a group of people working to positively impact the social determinants of health. The work of the network will be undertaken by actively caring for ourselves, each other, and the land that sustains us. It aims to work together to create policies, programs, infrastructure and amenities to make the region a better place to live, work, learn and play.
