I am writing this email in furtherance to the attached email my wife sent to you last evening in respect of the Covid-19 vaccine mandates for district staff, who are teaching two of our granddaughters, who are SD68 students.

I implore you to please look at the bigger picture of all of the ramifications of such mandates and the impact that such mandates and other related restrictions have and are continuing to have on Canadian citizens and, in particular, our children. There has and continues to be a loss of childhood innocence as we continue to fill our children and population, in general, with fear and divisiveness that we may, in fact, never, as a society, recover from.

No Canadian can ignore how politicized the entire Covid debate has become - fear can and is driving very bad behavior on many fronts, including those charged with decision-making that has ripple effects through our society at all levels. Is this really who we are or want to be?

Canada used to be a country of free choice, yet fear and lack of consistent, unfiltered information in respect of the mRNA vaccines and a willingness by the general public to get properly informed has driven bad behavior by people on all sides of the vaccine debate. Many Canadians have been unfairly labeled as "anti-vaxxers" because they have had concerns about the currently available Covid vaccines.
