That the Board of Education of School District No. 68 (Nanaimo-Ladysmith) approve the attached revised 2022/2023 Local School Calendar.

Background rovem

As you are aware, on June 3, 2021, the federal government announced that <u>Bill C-5</u>, An Act to amend the Bills of Exchange Act, the Interpretation Act and the Canada Labour Code (National Day for Truth and Reconciliation), had received Royal Assent and that the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation will be observed by federal government employees and by federally regulated workplaces every year, starting on September 30, 2021.

Our provincial government <u>announced</u> on March 23, 2022, that all provincial public sector employees will recognize September 30, 2022 - <u>the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation</u>, as a holiday for staff and students.

The 2022-23 district calendar has been updated to reflect that schools will be closed on September 30, 2022, and we can confirm that the minimum number of hours of instruction that must be offered as per the *School Act* and *Calendar Regulation*, have been met.
