SUBJECT: Environmental Sustainability Action Plan

Recommendation

That the Board of Education of School District No. 68 (Nanaimo-Ladysmith) adopt the attached draft Environmental Sustainability Action Plan.

Background

As you are aware, the third goal of the Board's strategic plan is to be a leader in environmental stewardship and sustainability. At the July 6, 2022, Special Board meeting the Environmental Stewardship and Sustainability Advisory Committee (the "Committee") presented the draft Environmental Sustainability Action Plan ("ESAP" or the "Plan") for consideration. The Board then passed the following motion:

That the Board of Education of School District No. 68 (Nanaimo-Ladysmith) recommends that staff make the attached draft Environmental Sustainability Action Plan available to the public for consultation immediately, as per Policy 2.17 Public Participation, and to report back in September with public feedback and any proposed changes.
