As part of the District's ongoing process of ensuring the currency of our Administrative Procedures, Administrative Procedure 422 – First Aid (the AP) has been updated. This Information Sheet outlines the notable changes.

Language has been changed to reflect that the responsibility for maintaining first aid supplies falls to schools, not stores, as is the current practice, and antiquated language has been removed.
