

Background

In the summer of 2023, the Board initiated the process of renewing the Strategic Plan (2019-2023) as it approached the end of its current cycle. To assist in this endeavor, the Board enlisted the services of consultant Piet Langstraat. As a crucial step in this renewal, the Board will actively seek input from the Nanaimo Ladysmith Public School Community from October 24th to November 26th. The objective is to present a preliminary draft of the strategic plan's goals and objectives to the community for their feedback, with a subsequent report to be submitted to the Business Committee in December.

Following the initial consultation period, the feedback received will be integrated into the comprehensive plan, which will then be shared with the public for a final round of feedback.

Community Engagement Plan

The draft Strategic Plan was be presented to the Board on **October 12, 2023**. The Board will make a decision to approve the draft and begin the community consultation process, which is proposed to run from October 26 to November 24, 2023.
