Soon they will be planting native plants with the help of NALT such a great learning opportunity, and a great example of environmental stewardship. Right now students are working on decorating door hangers to leave at peoples doors all around the neighborhood to remind everyone not to dump yard waste near the entrances or trails. On the last Pro D day, November 3 the primary teachers did theirs on the science of reading. The University of Florida Institute has a systematic way of phonics and graphics, connection science and print and encoding. The intermediate staff took theirs on morphing, magic, morphological awareness.
