

## Administrative Procedure 108 – Board Recognition

**AP 108 – Board Recognition****Purpose**

Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools will recognize Board members based on total completed terms of public service.

**Procedure**

The following levels of recognition are at the sole discretion of the Board and are proposed for all current and past School Trustees:

- One to Two Completed Terms
  - Acknowledgement Certificate
- Three or more Completed Terms
  - A Trustee will receive a pin for the duration of their time on the Board of Education. Trustees with more than three completed terms will receive a pin that corresponds with their most recent completed term.
- Four to Five Completed Terms
  - Individual photo and bio in Trustee's album. If the Trustee is elected for another term, this information will be updated at the end of the term.
- Six or more Completed Terms
  - Commemoration plaque with photo and bio. The plaque, must first be nominated by the Board of the day, and will be displayed on a designated wall in the Boardroom.
