### Recommendation

That th<mark>e Board of Education of School Di</mark>strict No. 68 (Nanaimo-Ladysmith) approve th<mark>e attached revised 2021/2022 Local School Calendar</mark>.

## Background

As you are aware, on June 3, 2021, the federal government announced that <u>Bill C-5</u>, An Act to amend the Bills of Exchange Act, the Interpretation Act and the Canada Labour Code (National Day for Truth and Reconciliation), had received Royal Assent and that the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation will be observed by federal government employees and by federally regulated workplaces every year, starting on September 30, 2021.

Our provincial government has also recognized the importance of honouring a day for Truth and Reconciliation. Accordingly, all provincial public sector employers, which includes public school districts, will recognize September 30, 2021, the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, as a holiday for staff and students this school year.

The 2021-22 <u>district calendar</u> has been updated, together with the minimum number of hours of instruction that must be offered as per the *School Act* and *Calendar Regulation*, as directed by the Ministry of Education.
