- Hot water heating line adjacent to outside wall burst flooding Day Care Rm. 107
- Called in Operations and Maintenance to remove water and clean
- Transferred all items that were on the floor in room 107 to room 105m
- Restoration company called to site- dehumidifier and fans installed
- Estimated time to occupy would be determined by restoration company, likely next week
